<b>Administrative Grant:</b> For Approved Rescue Entities to help defray the expenses incurred in their incorporation and process of requesting IRS 501(c)(3) status. The limit is \$1,000, and receipts must be included with the application	\$
<b>Spay/Neuter Grant:</b> A maximum of 10 per year up to \$300 per dog, with a maximum of \$1,000 for special circumstances per incident (with explanation). Vet/shelter/clinic invoices, and a photo and description of the dog to be attachment to the application.	\$
<b>Emergency Medical Grant (EMG):</b> Per incident, requests can be 50% of final bill or a maximum of \$1,000. Itemized statement, quote, or bill and prognosis on veterinarian's letterhead, and photo and description attachments to accompany application.	\$
<b>Humanitarian Grant:</b> Please refer to the Trusts Rescue web page for requirements.	\$
<b>Other Requests:</b> Written request and all pertinent information are required.	\$
<b>Mass Surrender/Seizure Grant:</b> This grant is designed to help Rescues and local Shelters/Humane Societies that receive a number of Siberians at one time due to a surrender or seizure situation. The number of dogs required to be considered as a "mass" situation depends both on the number of dogs received and the size of the receiving organization. Documentation, description, and photos will accompany the application process. Contact the Trust's Rescue Coordinator for more information.
